Approved at the County Association Executive Meeting on 11 April 2024 and requiring ratification, as follows:

Prior to tabling Motion 23/32(c) the Chairman advised those present that the purpose of a Management Board was succession planning and essential to the future of the County Association; to provide opportunity to gain first-hand experience in delivering the responsibilities that are the remit of the County Association. He emphasised that recruiting younger people to a Management Board of the County Association was crucial.

 - iii One from the Dorset Council authority area (North Dorset, Blandford, Bere Regis, Wareham, West Dorset, Weymouth, Weyport Masters, Weymouth & Portland WPC, Bridport), plus one from the BCP authority area (Poole, Bournemouth SC, Swim Bournemouth, Seagulls, Bournemouth Collegiate), plus one other.
